

SCHEDULE C: DELEGATIONS

The College has approved the following delegation of authority under these regulations.

'Delegation of authority' means that the body or person responsible for an action, process or decision under these policies or regulations has formally agreed that another body or person in the College can do or decide this for them.

If the delegation is listed below as 'exclusive', this means the original body or person listed in the policy or regulation cannot do or make the decision referred to. If it is listed as 'non-exclusive', this means the original body or person, and the person delegated to, can perform the action or make the decision referred to.
